#### NOTICE OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BLACKBURN CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

The Blackburn Creek Community Development District Board of Supervisors ("Board") will hold public hearings on July 11, 2018 at 12:30 p.m. at 5800 Lakewood Ranch Blvd., Sarasota, FL 34240, to consider the adoption of an assessment roll, the imposition of special assessments to secure proposed bonds on benefited lands within the Blackburn Creek Community Development District ("District"), a depiction of the pertinent Phase 2C Lands is shown below, and to provide for the levy, collection and enforcement of the special assessments. The streets and areas to be improved are depicted below and in the District's Supplemental Engineer's Report For Blackburn Creek Community Development District's 3<sup>rd</sup> Bond Issuance dated February 6, 2018 (Revised) [Phase 2C Lands] (the "Improvement Plan"). The public hearing is being conducted pursuant to Chapters 170 190 and 197, Florida Statutes. A description of the property to be assessed and the amount to be assessed to each piece or parcel of property may be ascertained at the District's Records Office located at 12051 Corporate Boulevard, Orlando, Florida 32817, the District's Local Records Office located at 5800 Lakewood Ranch Blvd, Sarasota, FL 34240, or by calling (407) 382-3256.

The District is a unit of special-purpose local government responsible for providing infrastructure improvements to serve lands within the District. The infrastructure improvements ("Improvements") are currently expected to include, but are not limited to, water and wastewater, drainage facilities, design, fees and permitting, all as more specifically described in the Improvement Plan, on file and available during normal business hours at the address provided above.

The District intends to impose assessments on benefited lands within the District in the manner set forth in the District's  ${\it Blackburn Creek Community Development District Supplemental Assessment Methodology (Series~2018~Bonds), ~ {\it dated~Febrular Creek Community Development District Supplemental Assessment Methodology}}$ ary 21, 2018 [Phase 2C Lands] (the "Assessment Report"), which is on file and available during normal business hours at the addresses provided above. The Assessment Report identifies each benefited and developable tax parcel identification number within the District and assessments per parcel for each land use category is currently expected to be assessed. The method of allocating assessments for the Improvements to be funded by the District will initially be determined on an equal assessment per benefited and developable acre basis. The methodology is explained in more detail in the Assessment Report. Also as described in more detail in the Assessment Report, the District's assessments will be levied against all assessable lands within the District.

Please consult the Assessment Report for more details.

The annual principal assessment levied against each parcel will be based on repayment over thirty (30) years of the total debt allocated to each parcel. The District expects to collect sufficient revenues to retire no more than \$3,482,488.00 in debt to be assessed by the District against the Phase 2C Lands, exclusive of fees and costs of collection or enforcement, discounts for early payment and interest. The proposed annual schedule of assessments is as follows:



 $The assessments \ may \ be \ prepaid \ in \ whole \ at \ any \ time, or \ in \ some \ instances \ in \ part, or \ may \ be \ paid \ in \ not \ more \ than \ thirty (30)$ annual installments subsequent to the issuance of debt to finance the improvements. These annual assessments will be collected on the Sarasota County tax roll by the Tax Collector. Alternatively, the District may choose to directly collect and enforce these assessments. All affected property owners have the right to appear at the public hearings and the right to file written objections with the District within twenty (20) days of the publication of this notice.

Also on July 11, 2018 at 12:30 p.m. at 5800 Lakewood Ranch Blvd., Sarasota, FL 34240, the Board will hold a regular public meeting to consider matters related to the construction of improvements; to consider matters related to a bond issue and special assessments to finance improvements; to consider the services and facilities to be provided by the District and the financing plan for same; and to consider any other business that may lawfully be considered by the District. The Board meeting and hearings are open to the public and will be conducted in accordance with the provisions of Florida law for community development districts. The Board meeting and/or the public hearings may be continued in progress to a date and time certain announced at the meeting and/or hearings.

If anyone chooses to appeal any decision of the Board with respect to any matter considered at the meeting or hearings, such person will need a record of the proceedings and should accordingly ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which such appeal is to be based.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE BLACKBURN CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOP-MENT DISTRICT DECLARING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS; INDICATING THE LOCATION, NATURE, TYPE AND ESTIMATED COST OF THOSE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS WHOSE COST IS TO BE DEFRAYED BY THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING THE PORTION OF THE ESTIMATED COST OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE DEFRAYED BY THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING THE MANNER IN WHICH SUCH SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE MADE; PROVIDING WHEN SUCH SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE MADE; DES-IGNATING LANDS UPON WHICH THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE LEVIED; PROVIDING FOR AN ASSESSMENT PLAT; ADOPTING A PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT ROLL; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Blackburn Creek Community Development District (the "Board") hereby determines to undertake, install, plan, establish, construct or reconstruct, enlarge or extend, equip, acquire, operate, and/or maintain the infrastructure improvements (the "Improvements") described in Exhibit "A," as incorporated herein by reference; provided however, the Improvements associated with this Resolution 2018-06 shall only be those specific Improvements described in Exhibit "A" of and pertaining to those specific lands within Grand Palm, Phase 2C (the "Phase 2C Lands"), as same are described in that certain Supplemental Engineer's Report for Blackburn Creek Community Development District's 3rd Bond Issuance Dated February 6, 2018, (Revised), and approved by the District on February 14, 2018, and conformed and ratified by the District on this  $11 th\ day\ of\ April,\ 2018,\ (the\ "Engineer's\ Report"),\ as\ attached\ here to\ as\ \underline{Exhibit\ "A,"}\ and\ incorporated\ herein;\ and,$ 

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Blackburn Creek Community Development District (the "District") to pay the costs of the Improvements associated with the Phase 2C Lands by special assessments pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes,

WHEREAS, the District is empowered by Chapter 190, the Uniform Community Development District Act, Chapter 170, Supplemental and Alternative Method of Making Local Municipal Improvements, and Chapter 197, the Uniform Method for the Levy, Collection and Enforcement of Non-Ad Valorem Assessments, Florida Statutes, to finance, fund, plan, establish, acquire, construct or reconstruct, enlarge or extend, equip, operate, and maintain the Improvements associated with the Phase 2C Lands and to impose, levy and collect the Assessments (as defined below); and,

WHEREAS, the District hereby determines that benefits will accrue to the Phase 2C Lands, the legal description describing same being attached hereto as Exhibit "C," and incorporated herein; and,

WHEREAS, the District hereby determines that the amount of those benefits attributed to the Phase 2C Lands and its associated Improvements have been determined, and that special assessments will be made in proportion to the benefits received, all as set forth in that certain Blackburn Creek Community Development District Supplemental Assessment Methodology (Series 2018 Bonds), Dated February 21, 2018, as approved by the District on February 28, 2018, and conformed and ratified by the District on this 11th day of April, 2018, (the "Assessment Report"), the same of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit "B,"** and incorporated herein. The Assessments described herein this Resolution 2018-06, (the "Phase 2C Assessment Resolution"), are specific to only the Improvements associated with the Phase 2C Lands and corresponding special assessments attributed to the Phase 2C Lands as described in the Assessment Report. # An American Tradition

Public notice is an important tool in assuring an informed citizenry. Notices are mandated by legislatures to make sure there is a public window into the activities of governments, officers of the court and others holding a public trust. There are four key elements to a valid public notice. It should be executed by an entity outside the one mandated to provide notice, so proper checks and balances are in place.

A public notice informs citizens of government or government-related activities that affect citizens' everyday lives. A public notice typically has four elements:

- Independent: A public notice is published in a forum independent of the government, typically in a local newspaper.
- Archivable: A public notice is archived in a secure and publicly available format.
- · Accessible: A public notice is capable of being accessed by all segments of society.
- Verifiable: The public and the source f the notice are able to verify that the notice was published, usually by an affidavit provided by the publisher.

(Adapted from the Public Resource Notice Center)

# Types of Public Notices

There are three standard types: Citizen participation notices

inform the public about proposed government action and allow the public time to react to such proposals.

One such example is a public hearing notice.

Business and commerce notices

relate to government contracts and purchases. Notices of contract bids allow citizens to ensure that the government is operating in accordance with principles of equal opportunity and is acting responsibly in spending taxpayer money.

• Court notices are required of many non-governmental entities that

use public powers or institutions in some way. Examples include notices of home mortgage foreclosures, which can provide a public alert of widespread credit problems, fraud in underwriting and a basis for analyses of housing trends.

This notice allows the public to object to an appointment based on any conflict of interest.

# The history of public notices

Public notices existed long before the emergence of newspapers. The concept itself began when early civilizations posted notices in public squares. This crude method was eventually refined with the publication of the first English language newspaper in 1665 - a court newspaper called the Oxford Gazette. After being renamed The London Gazette, this official newspaper carried notices from the King's Court, London

officials and outlying regions.

The American system is modeled after the British system. State governments published public notices before America's founding, and the newly-created federal government followed suit. In 1789, the Acts of the First Congress required the Secretary of State to publish all bills, orders, resolutions and congressional votes in at least three publicly available

An important premise both in federal

and local governments of the United States, as well as in many republics around the world, is that information about government activities must be accessible for the electorate to make well-informed decisions.

Public notices in newspapers still provide this accessibility to citizens who want to know more about government activities. Public notice laws serve to outline the most effective method of reaching the public.

# **Public notice supports due process**

Public notices are integral to democratic governance and stem from the right to "due process of law" guaranteed by the federal and state constitutions. Due process of law protects Americans' rights from arbitrary or wrongful violations. This concept has two parts: substantive due process and procedural due process.

Substantive due process refers to the

types of rights that are protected. Procedural due process refers to the means of protecting those rights.

Substantive due process ensures that certain basic rights are not violated, while procedural due process may require suitable notice and a hearing before a government or court-appointed body can act in a way that may affect those basic rights.

Public notices play a vital role in

substantive and procedural due process because they provide a window into government actions and also afford notice to citizens of actions about to take place so they may exercise their constitutional right to be heard. Notification not only informs the individual or entity most directly affected, but it also informs the public, which has an interest in knowing how public powers are being used.

# **ONLY ON THE INTERNET** Although it has been part of American

society for a quarter-century as a network for scholars and government agencies, the Internet has been widely used by citizens for

Because of its structure with computer clients and servers, information packets and open-network codes, the Internet remains vulnerable and sometimes unstable. Power surges, corrupted software and downed servers can disrupt access. Government agencies cannot ensure that information located on a server is secure.

Even a highly technological site like that of the Pentagon's has been affected. In June 2007, the Pentagon was forced to take about 1,500 computers off-line because of a cyberattack. Then-Defense Department Secretary Robert Gates stated that the Pentagon sees hundreds of attacks every day.

Public notices guard our constitutional right to due process of law by informing citizens of government action and providing proof of publication via notarized affidavits of publication. Unlike the time-tested and trusted local newspapers that citizens have come to rely on for public notices, the Internet is an unstable medium for information. While it is valuable tool in disseminating information, it has not yet reached a level of sophistication and technological stability that would justify its supplanting newspapers as the primary venue for public notices.

It is still uncertain how a "Net" affidavit could show proof of a public notice publication when constant technological change makes any attempt at archiving and accessing such a document online for any significant time dubious.

No less problematic for the Internet is its reach. Those who live in rural areas where broadband does not exist and others who simply cannot afford the Internet cannot access web public notices. In situations where foreclosures are on the rise due, in part, to predatory mortgage lending, more, not less, access to public notices is needed to better inform citizens about their rights and

It is difficult to justify, then, moving public notices from newspapers only to publicnotice Web sites administered either by already over-burdened state governments or by third-party vendors who lack the experience and long-term viability newspapers have proven in publishing notices.

So far in the Internet age, newspapers remain the most trusted and primary method for providing citizens access to public notices.

# WHY NEWSPAPERS?

# **Newspapers are the primary source**

Newspapers, founded on the constitutional right of free press, have been serving the public's right to know in America since precolonial times and on the European continent since the 17th century. Because of their traditional information role in society and their long-established independence, newspapers remain the primary source for publishing public notices.

Upholding the public's right to know is essential to our country's way of life. Our government governs with the consent of the people, and this consent must be informed. Local newspapers keep the public informed about the inner workings of their respective state and local governments, thereby allowing citizens to participate more fully in the democratic process. Without this participation, the potential for misguided policies increases.

# Newspaper tradition

Newspapers allow the government to notify the public of government actions. The government has a fundamental responsibility to ensure adequate notification to the public of its actions. Therefore, the government has a duty to make sure the methods used in satisfying this responsibility are the most effective.

Newspapers provide neutrality from government and credible distance from political pressures or partisan disagreements. Local and community newspapers serve as third-party reporters to the public, publishing information that can be beneficial or sometimes detrimental to the government's public image. They provide an environment for notices that the

public traditionally has regarded as neutral. Public notices in this print environment gain credibility because of the long history of trust in the local newspaper.

Placing notices on government Web sites undermines this neutral interest and removes a critical check and balance. While it may seem appealing on the surface in an age of ever-more sophisticated government Web sites, the potential for mishandling is great.

On the other hand, public notices in independent newspapers increase government transparency by opening up the decisionmaking process to the public's eyes. Without this oversight, local governments could enact controversial policies without input from the public.

Newspapers serve as effective monitors of governments and ensure that they publish information as required by law. Public notices are typically required by a statute or a regulation. The independent press can provide a valuable civic role by helping to monitor that the notices were published when required. If governments were responsible for publishing their own notices, no neutral and independent entity would have the incentive and the means to track public-notice publication.

# **Newspapers: The best** medium for public notices

Newspapers, for the most of the republic's history, have been the accepted medium for public notices. This is exactly where the public, even infrequent readers, expects to find them. In addition, specialized publications, such as legal newspapers, are well known for

providing public notices to the population through legal communities. Other general interest newspapers, such as county seat weeklies, are the forum where county citizens expect to locate notices of important public

business. Furthermore, the vast majority of these notices arrive at citizens' homes in a context that compels readership (amid local news, sports features and other content).

Another reason for the effectiveness of newspapers is that newspapers provide valid evidence of readership.

Legislatures are rightly concerned about web-only notices, given the digital divide between rich and poor, rural and urban residents. The Internet is either too costly or simply geographically unavailable to large segments of society.

## Notices become historical records

The newspaper as paper of record is an important factor in the public policy of notices. Government Web sites cannot provide a secure archival history the way newspapers can. Electronic records lack permanence and can easily be intentionally or accidentally erased. Even the Library of Congress has recognized this shortcoming and has embarked upon a major project to attempt to archive digital records that are in danger of being "forever lost" due to Internet impermanence.

Despite these problems, the federal courts unwisely approved a rule change to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure recently that would move notices of federal asset forfeitures out of newspapers and onto a Web site administered by the Department of Justice. Yet, the courts have little research to show that the Justice Department's Web site will produce viable, ac-

cessible, archivable notices.

While Internet web pages pose serious archiving challenges, newspapers, on the other hand, become historical documents. They are oriented and published with a date on every page. They cannot be deceptively altered after printing as a web page could. Historians, judges, lawyers, genealogists and researchers, to name only a few, use newspapers and public notices in particular as sources for records.

## **Newspaper notices** protect due process

Procedural due process, as granted by the U.S. Constitution and interpreted

by courts, generally requires an individual to receive notice and a hearing before he or she is deprived of certain rights or property. For example, before a person's home is sold by a county sheriff at a foreclosure sale, he or she must receive notice of the foreclosure sale and an opportunity to save the house from foreclosure. If the owner does not receive the notice, he may challenge the sale in court. The court may then void the sale or prevent the sale from happening to protect due process.

Newspapers are generally paid to run public notices, which recognizes that their publication creates a cost in paper, ink and delivery.
