The purpose of the Re- ceivership is to remove the pond water inventory, maintain, repair, and perman- ently close the Stack System so that it is no longer a threat to public safety and the environment. This procurement is for the closure of one of the four former phospho- gypsum stack compartments, the Old Gyp Stack - South (the "OGS-S"). The OGS- S has an area of approximately 24 acres and does not currently hold standing wa- ter, except any accumulated rainfall. The OGS-S compartment was partially closed (i.e., lined with HDPE liner) and used to store marine sediments generated by the dredge operations, and does not contain phosphate industry related process water.
