This is to give notice that Arcadia (under 24 CFR Part 58) has determined that the following proposed action - under Florida Department of Commerce and Housing and Urban Development (Grant No. MT045), is located in a Federal Flood Risk Management Standard (FFRMS) floodplain and wetland, and the city of Arcadia and George F. Young Inc. will be identifying and evaluating practicable alternatives to locating the action within the floodplain and wetland, and the potential impacts on the floodplain and wetland from the proposed action, as required by Executive Order 11988, as amended by Executive Order 13690 and/or Executive Order 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 in Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management and Protection of Wetlands.

The City of Arcadia (in DeSoto County) has proposed a drainage improvement project to the Jordan Branch (Channel Tributary E) which runs from Highway 17 and Maple Street southwest to W Magnolia Street and S Dade Avenue, then west to the railroad, then north to W Hickory Street where it crosses under the railroad and into the Peace River. The extent of the FFRMS floodplain was determined using the 0.2 percent flood approach. This project includes the widening and stabilizing of 1.35 miles of the drainage channel, the replacement of 17 box culverts to prevent major flooding and increase outfall volume to the Peace River.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in the floodplain or wetland, and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Commenters are encouraged to offer alternative sites outside of the floodplain/wetland, alternative methods to serve the same project purpose, and methods to minimize and mitigate project impacts on the floodplain/wetland.

La ciudad de Arcadia (en el condado DeSoto) ha propuesto un proyecto para mejorar el drenaje al Jordan Branch (Channel Tributary E), que corre desde la Carretera 17 y Maple Street, sudoeste, hasta W Magnolia Street y S Dade Avenue, y entonces oeste hasta la línea de ferrocarril, y hacia el norte hasta W Hickory Street donde cruce por debajo la línea de ferrocarril y al Peace River. La medida del FFRMS valle inundable fue determinado usando la consideración de 0.2 por ciento. El proyecto incluye el ensanchamiento y estabilizando 1.35 millas de canal de drenaje, reemplazamiento de 17 alcantarillas de cajón para prevenir inmensa inundación y aumentar el volumen de descarga al Peace River.

Este aviso tiene tres propósitos principales.
