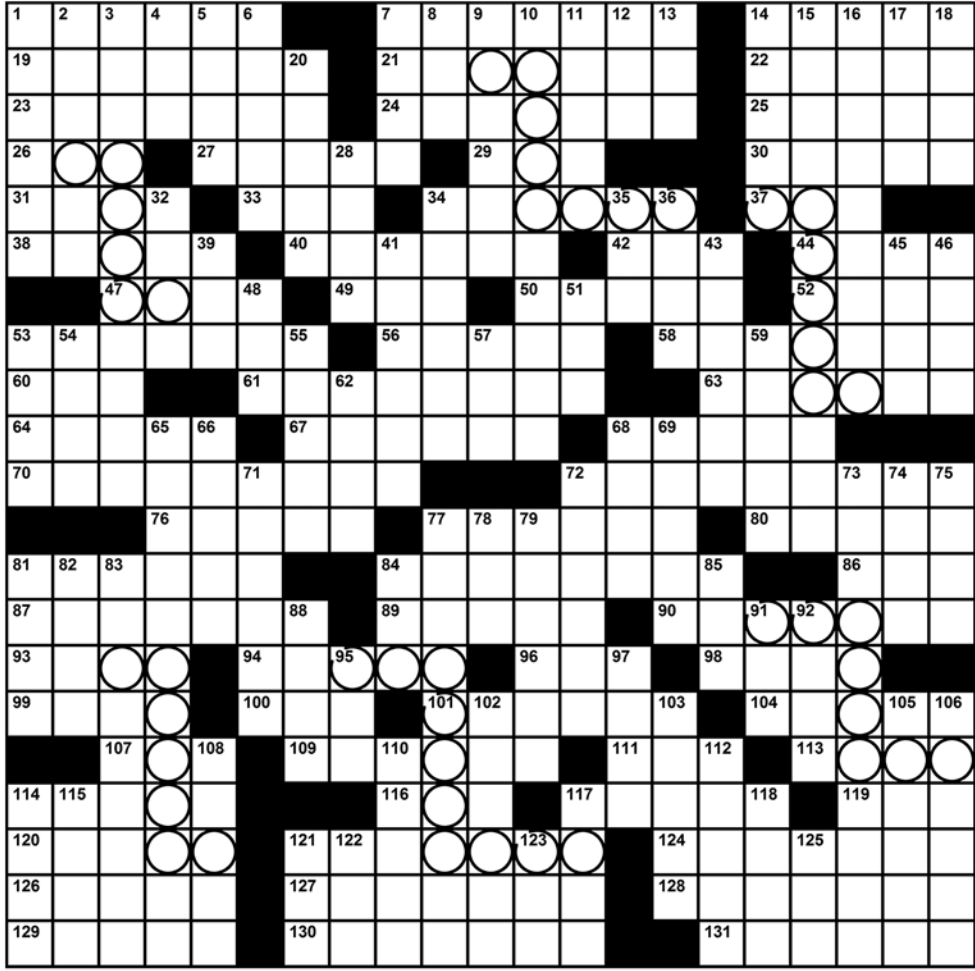

I decided to have the surgery."

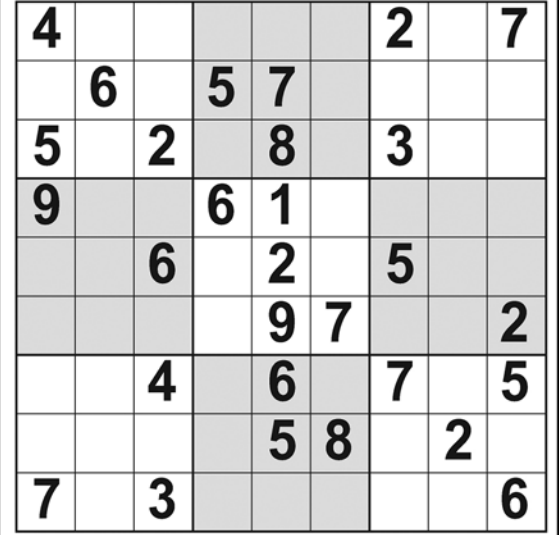
